

NLC Re-opening Phases - Summer 2020

New Life Church - Phase 1

- Phase 1 will last between two (2) to four (4) weeks
- NLC will adhere to a Safe, Sanitized, and Socially distanced environment
- There will be a No Physical Contact policy
 - No Handshakes, Hugs, or High fives
- There will be three (3) identical Sunday Services at 9:00 A.M., 11:00 A.M., and 1:00 P.M.
 - A first come first serve sign-up sheet will be posted to the church website to sign up for each service.
 - *Deference will be given to the older congregants.*
 - *Link/Portable will launch at noon on Tuesday, May 19th.*
 - *Each service will be capped at 150 people*
 - There will be no fellowship portion of the service
 - There will be no children's church or nursery services
 - There will be NO choir ministry until Phase 4
- There will be several offering deposit locations in the foyer accompanied by an usher
- There will be certain pews designated for certain services with a 6 foot section taped off to ensure that it will not be used for social distancing purposes
 - *(A) Red pews – 9:00 A.M. and 1:00 P.M. services; these pews will be sanitized between the 9:00 A.M. and 11:00 A.M. services*
 - *(B) Blue pews – 11:00 A.M. service; these pews will be sanitized after the 1:00 P.M. service*
 - *There will be no choir during the services*
 - *9:00 A.M. and 11:00 A.M. services will be livestreamed*
 - The fellowship hall will be set up with overflow seating for families with small children that potentially could be problematic during the service.
 - *There will be 2 TV's set up that will livestream the service for those with children or for overflow needs.*
- There will be a door designated for entrance and a separate door designated for exit
- There will be no water fountain use
- There will be deep sanitization:
 - After the 9:00 A.M. and 11:00 A.M. services, light switches, door handles, restrooms, and other high contact areas will be wiped down with disinfectant
 - After the 1:00 P.M. service, light switches, door handles, restrooms, and other high contact areas will be wiped down with disinfectant. The pews will be disinfected and there will be a deep clean of the restrooms
- There will be ushers/ greeters stationed throughout the foyer to help minimize crowd concentration and to help support the No Physical Contact policy
- There will be ushers/ greeters stationed at the restrooms to limit the amount of people in the restroom to three (3)
- Wednesday evening Bible study and Sunday School will be online

- Sunday evening Life Groups will be able to meet under the following conditions:
 - Life groups that are less than ten (10) may meet in homes
 - Life groups more than ten (10) may meet outside anywhere, at church, in the library, in the gym, or in teen church.
 - Anyone meeting on church property will need to book the space through the church office
 - The life group leaders will be responsible for appropriately sanitizing used areas

WORK ONE - WORSHIP ONE (Sanitizing, Security (4)/Ushers (4), Greeters, Media, Meals)

New Life Church - Phase 2

- Phase 2 will last between two (2) to four (4) weeks
- The No Physical Contact will be maintained
- The three (3) Sunday services will continue status quo
- Wednesday evening Bible study and Sunday School will continue online
- There will be no nursery services
- Children's church during the Sunday services will be offered 9am and 11am:
 - Social distancing will be maintained
 - Seating separation restrictions will be observed
 - All activities that involve physical contact within children's church will be suspended
 - All activities that involve shared items will be suspended
- There will be ushers/ greeters stationed throughout the foyer to help minimize crowd concentration and to help support the no physical contact policy
- There will be ushers/ greeters stationed at the restrooms to limit the amount of people in the restroom to three (3)
- There will be no water fountain use
- There will be a door designated for entrance and a separate door designated for exit
- There will be deep sanitization:
 - After the 9:00 A.M. and 11:00 A.M. services, light switches, door handles, restrooms, and other high contact areas will be wiped down with disinfectant
 - After the 1:00 P.M. service, light switches, door handles, restrooms, and other high contact areas will be wiped down with disinfectant. The pews will be disinfected and there will be a deep clean of the restrooms
 - This same pattern will apply to children's church facilities
- Sunday evening Life Groups will be able to meet under the following conditions:
 - Life groups will go back to normal meetings in homes and at church

New Life Church - Phase 3

- Phase 3 will last between two (2) to four (4) weeks
- The No Physical Contact will be maintained

- We will go back to two (2) Sunday services at 9:00 A.M. and 11:00 A.M.
- Wednesday evening Bible study will begin on campus with Kids and Teen services as well
- Sunday School will continue online
- Children's church restrictions and regulations will be maintained
- Nursery services will be offered during the Sunday services at 50% capacity:
 - A strict nursery cleaning schedule will be implemented
 - Strict nursery rules concerning shared items will be implemented
- Ministry activities will return (Bible studies, fellowships, youth activities, etc.)
- There will be ushers/ greeters stationed throughout the foyer to help minimize crowd concentration and to help support the no physical contact policy
- There will be a door designated for entrance and a separate door designated for exit
- There will be deep sanitization:
 - After the 9:00 A.M. and 11:00 A.M. services, light switches, door handles, restrooms, and other high contact areas will be wiped down with disinfectant
 - This same pattern will apply to children's church facilities

New Life Church - Phase 4

- Phase 4 will last indefinitely
- Sunday services will return to 9:00 A.M. and 11:00 A.M.
 - There will be no pew or number restrictions
 - There will be choir
 - There will be no social distancing
- Wednesday evening Bible study will return
 - This includes AWANAs and nursery
- Sunday School will return to campus at 10:00 A.M.
- Nursery will return to normal capacity with enhanced cleaning routine
- Ministry activities will return (Bible studies, fellowships, youth activities, etc.)
- Deep sanitization will continue:
 - After the 9:00 A.M. service and 10:00 A.M. Sunday School, light switches, door handles, restrooms, and other high contact areas will be wiped down with disinfectant
 - After the 11:00 A.M. service, light switches, door handles, restrooms, and other high contact areas will be wiped down with disinfectant. The pews will be disinfected and there will be a deep clean of the restrooms
 - This same pattern will apply to children's church facilities
